After the students form small ensembles they will be given a challenge to perform the next day. For instance, on Monday they might be given the task to perform something in 6/8 time. They will select a piece from a group we will have available, work it up to the appropriate style and decide if they would like to bring props, dress up, etc to enhance their chances to win. Our panel of judges (much nicer than Simon and including "celebrity judges") will give each group constructive feedback about preparation and style. Students will win small daily prizes based on these performances. It will be tons of fun!

Optional Young Artist Contest

Prizes awarded in two categories: Middle School and High School (M.S.=entering 7-9th grade)
(H.S.=entering 10-12th grade)

Solos must be selected and performed in accordance with UIL solo and ensemble rules.

Students must provide their own accompanist or they will be unable to participate.

Winners will perform on a concert Thursday afternoon at 2:30 and must provide their own accompanist or forfeit.

High School prize winners will receive:

Middle School prize winners will receive:
