

Student Performances . . .

Each Froot Fire participant should be prepared to perform at least twice in performance class. It is preferred that different selections, or different sections from the same piece, be performed. Our pianists will accompany each performer. Please bring your piano parts with you! (Unaccompanied works are acceptable.)

Deadlines and Fees . . .

Registration deadline is **June 2, 2008**. Your payment guarantees a place in the workshop.

Tuition: \$295

(or \$150 Half Day option for Froot Flicker only)

Solo Competition Entry Fee: \$30.00 (if participating)

Competition Accompanist Fee: \$30.00 (if requested)

A \$50 non-refundable deposit (credited toward tuition) may be sent with your registration form in lieu of the full tuition payment. In this case, the balance of your payment will be due no later than **June 10, 2008**.

Late registrations (for the workshop only) accepted on a "space available" basis and are subject to a \$10 late fee.
